

EXTENDED INFORMATION ON COOKIES - COOKIE POLICY

What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by users send to their terminals, where they are stored to be retransmitted to the same sites on subsequent visits. Cookies are used for different purposes, have different characteristics, and can be used both by the owner of the site you are visiting and by third parties. Below you will find all the information on the cookies installed through this site, and the necessary information on how to manage your preferences regarding them.

Technical cookies that do not require consent

This Website uses technical session cookies strictly necessary for the functioning of the site, for the provision of the service and for the optimization of navigation, as well as technical cookies relating to the saving of preferences (specifically in relation to language preferences). and optimization of the service. These cookies do not collect information about the user nor trace the profile of visitors to the site. Specifically, they are used:

- PHPSESSID (session cookie): allows the site to identify the user's status and connected users. The cookie is valid only during the current browser session and will be deleted when the browser is closed;

EXPIRY: Session

- cookie_notice_accepted: These cookies are used to display the information on the use of cookies. They do not record any personally identifiable information.

DURATION: 30 Days

The site also uses third party statistics cookies (Google Analytics) to collect information in aggregate form. Google Analytics is set as a technical cookie, ie without tracking the User's IP (user data not profiled at the IP level) and without sharing data with the Third Party. All technical cookies do not require consent, so they are installed automatically following access to the site.

Cookies for which consent is required

All cookies other than the technical ones mentioned above are installed or activated only following the consent given by the user the first time they visit the site. Consent can be expressed in a general way, by interacting with the brief information banner present on the landing page of the site, according to the methods indicated in this banner (by clicking on the OK button or on the X button; or by continuing to browse, even with the scroll or through a link); or it can be provided or denied selectively, according to the methods indicated below. This consent is tracked on the occasion of subsequent visits. However, the user always has the option of revoking all or part of the consent already expressed.

Other technologies (e.g. plugins, widgets, local storage, etc.)

Interaction with social networks and external platforms

Plugin: is a program that interacts with another program to expand or extend its original functionality. The most used plugins are those of social networks, which allow, for example, the user to follow a page or a social profile with a click, to indicate with a click that he has liked a web content and to share it on his social network profile etc.;

Widget: is a graphical user interface component of a program, which aims to facilitate the user interaction with the program itself. The most used widgets are those of social networks, which allow users to easily open social networks in a separate browser window.

These services allow interaction with social networks or other external platforms directly from the pages of a site. The interactions and any information acquired by the site are subject to the privacy settings of the third party who created the aforementioned technologies.
